

# ***Student Registration for 2017-2018 School Year***

## **Returning Students**

All returning students from all schools will need to register for the 2017-2018 school year. Registration can be done in two ways:

### ***Online***

Open from July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 – August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017

Register from the comfort of your own home or at the Public Library!

### ***In-Person Registration***

July 31<sup>st</sup> or August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 at your child's district school. 9:00-3:00

Register in person in the school computer labs (come in to main office for direction)

**New students and Kindergarten students must prove they live in the River Forest Community School District.**

This is done by bringing in the following (6) original documents (no photocopies).

They are:

Mortgage papers or tax receipt (Proof of Residency)

Utility bill

Driver's License

Water Bill

Birth Certificate

Shot Records

\*Custodial or Proof of Guardianship papers for extenuating circumstances

Families that rent need to bring in these (6) original documents (no photocopies). They are:

Lease/Rental Agreement

A bill mailed to the home showing the home address

Driver's License

Utility Bill or a pay stub with current address, or a second bill, or a public assistance document

Birth Certificate

Shot Records

\*Custodial or Proof of Guardianship papers for extenuating circumstances

Families that live with other people need to have the homeowner sign an affidavit affirming the student's family lives with them *and* bring in these (3) original documents belonging to the homeowner (no photocopies). They are:

Mortgage papers or Tax Receipt

Utility Bill

Water Bill

Birth Certificate

Driver's License

Shot Records
