

Student Registration for 2019-2020 School Year

Kindergarten Registration

June 13, 2019 at River Forest High School. 1:00-5:30

See below for appropriate list of what to bring. Your child will be screened when you arrive and may be recommended for our Jumpstart Program which begins on July 29th at Meister Elementary School.

Resident Students New to District

All resident students new to the district will need to register for the 2019-2020 school year. Registration can be done on the following dates:

June 13, 2019 at River Forest High School. 1:00-5:30

Register in person in the school computer labs (come to the main office for direction)

July 30, 2019 or July 31, 2019 at your child's district school. 9:00-3:00

See below for appropriate list of what to bring.

All new students must prove they live in the River Forest Community School District. This is done by bringing in the following (4) original documents (no photocopies). They are:

Mortgage papers or tax receipt

Utility bill

Driver's License

Water Bill

Families that rent need to bring in these (4) original documents (no photocopies). They are:

Lease/Rental Agreement

A bill mailed to the home showing the home address

Driver's License

Utility Bill or a pay stub with current address, or a second bill, or a public assistance document

Families that live with other people need to have the homeowner sign an affidavit affirming the student's family lives with them *and* bring in these (4) original documents belonging to the homeowner (no photocopies). They are:

Mortgage papers or Tax Receipt

Utility Bill

Driver's License

Water Bill

PARENTS MUST ALSO PROVIDE AN ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE, IMMUNIZATION RECORDS, AND ANY CUSTODIAL/GUARDIANSHIP DOCUMENTS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES

New Non-Resident Tuition Students

New Non-Resident Tuition enrollment packets will be made available from May 6- June 13. Packets can be picked up at the Central Administrative office from 9 -2 or can be printed from the River Forest Community School Corporation website under announcements.

Packets can be returned to the Central Administrative office for your convenience.

The tuition fee for the 2019-2020 school year is \$100 for the 1st student in family and \$25 for each additional student. A \$25 deposit toward cost of tuition is required per student with the tuition application packet.

Deadline for all new Non-Resident Tuition Students is June 13, 2019
